**DCSE Referrals Make a Difference:** A noncustodial father struggled to pay child support after losing his job. Because his case was open with DCSE, he was eligible for Family Engagement services. Upon enrolling in a family

engagement program, he worked with a DCSE case manager to create a Parent Action Plan. He was quickly able to sign up for SNAP and Medicaid; gain access to 63 free, online courses; dust off his resume, and find employment. Not only was he back on track **providing support**, he received a 20% reduction off his TANF debt.
