The Virginia Department of Social Services (VDSS) Division of Licensing Programs (DOLP) has developed a model Infection Control Plan Manual template for use by assisted living facilities (ALFs) as part of the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity for Prevention and Control of Emerging Infectious Diseases Cooperative Agreement (ELC) grant received from the Virginia Department of Health (VDH). This template allows ALF providers to customize their facility's infection control plans to suit the operations of the facility based on licensure type, capacity, staffing, and services offered.
