Explanation of Sworn Statement or Affirmation

Requirement: Section 63.2-1726 of the Code of Virginia (Code) requires individuals to provide a sworn statement or affirmation to a children's residential facility attesting to whether he/she has ever been i) convicted of or is the subject of pending charges for any offense within or outside the Commonwealth and ii) the subject of a founded case of child abuse or neglect within or outside the Commonwealth. The statement or affirmation must be made available to the Department of Social Services' representative.

The following individuals must provide sworn statements or affirmations:

- Individuals who accept a position of employment for a children's residential facility;
- Individuals who volunteer for a children's residential facility; and
- Individuals who provide contractual services directly to a juvenile for such a facility.

Further dissemination of the sworn statement information is prohibited other than to the Commissioner's representative or a federal or state authority or court in order to comply with an express requirement in the law for that dissemination.
