SUBJECT: 2023 Legislative Information

The purpose of this memorandum is to inform you of the legislation that passed in the 2023 General Assembly session that affects children's residential facilities.

[Senate Bill 1508](#)

This bill amends and reenacts § 63.2-1707 of the Code of Virginia, to increase the maximum time an applicant may operate an assisted living facility, adult day care center, or child welfare agency under a provisional license from six months to twelve successive months. Out of over 800 licensed facilities, only five facilities currently have a provisional license.

This is effective on July 1, 2023.
